



Day 4 GAME IDEA: CROSS THE DIVIDE

Today we're talking a lot about forever and how Jesus' power lets us live forever. (Trust Jesus!) Forever. Sounds kind of impossible, right? Impossible for us on our own, but not impossible with Jesus. We have limits, but Jesus doesn't.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Easy-to-catch balls, one for every two participants. (Beach balls work well)

HOW TO PLAY:

- Form pairs. If you have an uneven number, they can form one trio
- Give each pair a ball.
- Have pairs spread out with partners and facing each other and a few feet between each other
- Ask pairs to pretend they're standing on opposite sides of a mountain divide along Rocky Railway and have to get a train—a ball—across the divide.
- Have pairs toss a ball back and forth to each other. Every time they have a successful toss and catch, each partner should take a step backward and away from each other. Then toss and catch again.

WRAP-UP QUESTIONS: CROSS THE DIVIDE

1. *What happened in the game as the gap grew bigger?*
2. *What was it like to reach your limit for getting the ball across successfully?*

Say: This game shows us what sin—the wrong things we all say and do—does to us and God: Sin puts an impossible divide between us and God. But nothing is impossible for Jesus! Jesus made a way for all our sins to be forgiven so the divide between us and God goes away, forever. Jesus' power lets us live forever! (Trust Jesus!)
